



STAND OUT LEVEL UP CARD

Please see below our Rules for our BRAND NEW SOLO RESULTS CARD

How to Register

- Dancers can not compete in Solo without signing up for our Level Up Card
- All dancers at their first event with Stand Out UK must register at our reception desk before competing in solo to receive their card.
- Dancers must bring proof of ID with them, this can be a passport or birth certificate
- Dancers Name and Age will be taken and put on the front of the card.
- The first card will be Free of charge
- If a card is lost or stolen you will need to purchase a new card from the reception desk at the next event your attend
- Please remember your card at every event you attend.

Level Categories

- Newcomer
- Novice
- Intermediate
- Advance

Rules

- Dancers will need to bring their Level Up Card to the holding area for staff members to check they are competing in the correct category
- If a dancer has never competed at a Stand Out UK event before it is down to the dance teacher as to what category they start in
- Dancers who have never entered a competition before can compete in the Newcomer section
- If a dancer has more than 10 compete in their category and they place 1st-6th they will then receive a stamp on their card
- Once a dancer receives 3 stamps they will then move up to the next category
- If a dancer places in the Newcomer section, then they will automatically move up to the Novice section. You will only need to collect one stamp in this category.
- If a dancer has a birthday and moves up an age category they can move down a level, however a dancer can never move down to Newcomer.
- Only when a dancer changes age category they can change their level category. Dancers cannot change their category themselves.
- A dancer can only move down one category
 - o Example Advance to Intermediate or Intermediate to Novice
- A dancer can never move back down to newcomer as you are no longer new to competitions.
- Advance Dancers if you complete your card by having 3 advance stamps then you will qualify for Dancer of the year at the Ultimate.



Dancer of The Day

- If a dancer wins Dancer of the Day they will automatically move up to the next category.
- Dancers who Win Advance dancer of the day will remain in the Advance category

New Card

- Once a dancer moves up an age category, they will then need to purchase a new card.
- All dancers receive their first card free until they have a birthday and move up to a different age category.
 - o Example – moving from 10&Under to 12&under
- This will be a dancers responsibility to ensure that this rule is followed, Stand Out UK will have it on record however responsibility lies with the dancer

Lanyards

- Stand Out UK will have lanyards available to buy for dancers to keep their card safe.
- Newcomer – Green
- Novice – Yellow
- Intermediate – Orange
- Advance – Black

New to Stand Out UK

- It is your dance teacher's discretion as to what category you should compete in
- Once you have done your first competition with Stand Out UK then you will follow Stand Out UK's rules
- If you are ever unsure of which category you should compete in always ask a member of the team!
